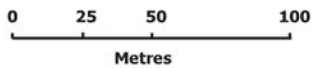


Como Lake Park Trails

A Guide to the Birds and Wildlife of Como Lake

Because of the lake and wetland, Como Lake is a popular location for nature enthusiasts who enjoy wildlife viewing. There are over 70 species of animals (mainly birds) that can be seen by visitors to the park at different times of the year. The lake is listed by Environment Canada as a stopover for migrating birds.

The Burke Mountain Naturalists have developed a brochure titled the "Birds and Other Wildlife of Como Lake Park". The guide is a great resource for wildlife enthusiasts and provides the general public with some great facts and information about Como Lake. The brochure includes a listing of the birds of Como Lake and what time of year you could expect to see them.
